

SJRYC HOUSE RULES

When the Club is booked for private parties, the 1st floor will be reserved for Members and their guests, unless the Clubhouse is closed.

Member guests must be accompanied at all times by the Member while on Club premises.

Members must show a current Membership Card at the bar when running a tab. Tabs must be paid before the Member leaves for the day. There is a \$5.00 charge if a tab is not paid the same day. Gratuities should be included at the time of payment. If children are not permitted to run a tab, the General Manager must be informed in writing. A form may be obtained from the website authorizing or denying such rights.

Glassware and china are not allowed outside of the building; plastic dishes and paper must be used.

Parents are responsible for their children any time they are on Club premises.

Children under 18 are not allowed in the Keeper's Bar or on the river side of the fence at the Rhumblin Bar, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian. They may not stand or sit at the bar counter, except on the grass (north) side of the Rhumblin Bar.

Children under 18 are not allowed above the first floor or in the basement of the Clubhouse unless supervised by an adult.

Only SJRYC staff, Board Members, or authorized Member volunteers are allowed behind the bar counter or in the galley. A tour may be arranged for the latter.

Members must wear footwear and a "cover" over swimsuits in the Clubhouse. Wearing wet swimsuits in the Clubhouse is not allowed except in lavatories, changing rooms, and their hallways.

Any and all alcoholic beverages must be purchased by a Member and consumed on Club property. Bringing alcoholic beverages onto Club property or taking an alcoholic beverage purchased at the Club off of Club property is strictly prohibited by State liquor law.

All food and beverages on the Club's grounds, except water, must be purchased from the Club.

In-town Member guests are limited to two times per month.

Reciprocity is granted to current Members of yacht clubs beyond a twenty-mile radius of SJRYC if that Club is listed in the Club reciprocity guides and their owned yacht or chartered yacht is not permanently moored in the St. Joseph/Benton Harbor marinas.

Members are allowed to bring up to 12 guests (with advance notice). More than 12 guests constitutes a private party and must be scheduled with the General Manager.

1. Tabs must be paid before the Member leaves for the day. There is a \$5 charge if tab is not paid the same day. Gratuities should be included at the time of payment. If children are not permitted to run a tab, the Manager must be informed in writing.
2. Glassware and china are not allowed outside the building; plastic/ paper must be used.
3. Parents are responsible for their children any time they are on Club premises.
4. Except the grass (north) side of the Rhumblin snack bar, children under 18 may not loiter at any SJRYC bar, but may approach the bar to order food. Children under 13 are not allowed on the river side of the fence at the Rhumblin Bar, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.
5. Children under 18 are not allowed above the first floor or in the basement unless supervised by an adult.
6. Only SJRYC staff, Board Members, or authorized Member volunteers are allowed behind the bar counter or in the galley. A tour may be arranged for the latter.
7. Members must wear footwear and a “cover” over swimsuits in the Clubhouse. Wet swimsuits are not allowed in the Clubhouse, except the lavatories and changing rooms, and the hallways to same.
8. Any and all alcoholic beverages must be purchased by a Member and consumed at the Club. Bringing alcoholic beverages in from the outside or taking a beverage purchased at the Club off Club property is strictly prohibited.
9. No food or beverage, except water, may be brought onto the Club grounds. Such must be purchased from the Club.
10. In-town guests are limited to twice each month.
11. Reciprocity is granted to current Members of yacht clubs beyond a twenty mile radius of SJRYC if this club is listed in the Club’s reciprocity guides and not moored within the St. Joseph/Benton Harbor marinas.
