

Good Afternoon,

There is a brief reminder that the Upton Drive Reconstruction Project will start tomorrow, Monday, March 25th.

Starting tomorrow morning, Upton Drive will be closed from Whitwam Drive to just north of the CSX railroad tracks. Kalin Construction informed the City they plan to begin with the following items of work.

- Remove pavement.
- Install a cofferdam as part of the new storm sewer work on the St. Joseph River near the south end of Upton Drive.
- Commence work on the south side of the St. Joseph River, on the east side of State Street, west of Lakeview Terrace in preparation for the directional bore of the new sanitary force main.

Kalin intends to maintain access to Anderson Builders and Holcim by leaving the westerly lane of pavement of Upton Drive in place for the time being. Access to the Lakeview Terrace parking on the east of the building will be maintained via Water Street, however, parking for the Arboretum Park at State & Water Street will be closed.

A water shut off is planned the week of April 1, 2025, more details will be provided in the coming week on it.
